



Today we will enjoy a three-hour narrated wildlife cruise that travels along Anacapa Islands scenic north shore (this is a non-landing cruise). Only 12 miles from the California coast, Anacapa Island is a small volcanic island and the closest of the Channel Islands. You will see the famous Arch Rock that is the

landmark for the park. Traveling from the mainland to the island of Anacapa you may see Harbor Seals, California Sea Lions, Humpback, Gray, Blue or Orca Whales. Common Dolphins, Pacific White-sided & Risso's Dolphins may also be sighted on these excursions.

After the cruise, enjoy time at leisure to browse the shops and enjoy lunch on your own in the scenic Ventura



Harbor Village. We will then visit the Channel Island Maritime Museum. If your idea of a maritime museum is limited to rusty anchors and old salty sea dogs, you will be pleasantly surprised with this vibrant cultural venue in that celebrates local maritime achievements through contemporary interactive exhibits and displays outstanding examples of centuries of fine art from around the world. We will discover a treasure trove of maritime paintings, ship models, and artifacts that rival some of the finest European and U.S. collections. Beautiful seascape paintings by 17th century Dutch masters, 18th and 19th century English Romantics, French Impressionist painter Boudin, and unparalleled contemporary maritime painters complement the finest museum-quality ship models on the West Coast.

Suggested: rubber-soled walking shoes and a sweater or jacket as it can be cool on the water. The boat has shaded and un-shaded areas, you will be provided with a drink and an onboard snack and there is a restroom onboard. Return time may vary.
