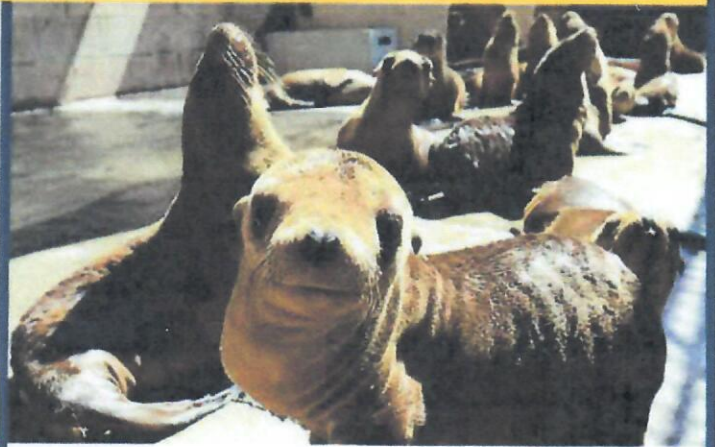
SEALS *and* SEA LIONS: Rescue and Release in San Pedro

The Marine Mammal Care Center in San Pedro is a unique facility that rehabilitates and releases, sick, injured, and malnourished seals and sea lions. On your guided tour, you'll see recovering seal and sea lion patients and learn how human interactions affect our ocean life. Guests will also observe animal care, feeding procedures, and learn about rehabilitation procedures we use to return the animals back to their ocean environment. At the conclusion of the tour, you'll have some time to visit the gift shop.

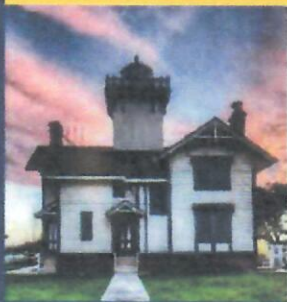

Built in 1874, the Point Fermin Light Station was the first navigational beacon into the San Pedro Bay. You'll be taken on a guided tour of the fascinating Victorian structure that is still a working lighthouse.
