



Our expert guide Curt Tucker will provide a fascinating journey through Pasadena to see its most beautiful and nostalgic landmarks, focusing on the history and architecture. Today we explore two of the most renowned homes in historic Pasadena that are known for the beauty, as well as their historical and architectural significance. First, a docent-guided tour of the Gamble House, which was designed by Charles Greene and Henry Greene in 1908 for David and Mary Gamble of the Procter & Gamble Company. The house is a National Historic Landmark and a true example of the American Arts & Crafts-style architecture. Also, enjoy a docent-guided tour of the Italian Renaissance-style, Wrigley Mansion – the historic home known as the “Tournament House.” Once owned by chewing-gum pioneer William Wrigley Jr. This grand house is a reminder of Pasadena’s early years. View its exquisite early 1900s-era interiors including Rose Parade memorabilia, and Rose Bowl trophies and memorabilia. Also, on our journey we will make a brief stop, at Arlington gardens check out the varied architecture amongst City Hall, Pasadena City College and Cal Tech and drive past the Rose Bowl and more,...

Enjoy an included buffet lunch with multiple choices of entrées at local favorite Mijares Mexican Restaurant. Here the Mexican culinary traditions are far older than the 1920’s landmark itself, featuring recipes passed down through generations of the Mijares family. Fresh ground salsas and tortillas made with volcanic stone tools are served alongside tasty favorites like the tostadas and marinated steak fajitas. Enjoy these filling and time-tested meals while soaking in the welcoming family-style atmosphere.
