



Step back in time with us as we explore some of San Bernardino's treasures. We will be starting our day at the historic **The Harvey House** in Barstow for a docent lead tour. This historical building is one of the last remaining Harvey Houses in the country. The structure is 103 years old and most everything is original to the building including the woodwork, lighting fixtures, and architecture.

Our next stop will be for lunch at **Peggy Sues 50's Diner**. The diner was built in 1954 with only 9 counter stools and 3 booths. The building consisted of railroad ties and mortar from the nearby Union Pacific Rail yard. It has since expanded, but the menu has stayed true to the 50's era. Our lunch will include an old fashion Peggy Sue's 50's hamburger, curly fries, coleslaw, and a drink.

After lunch we will travel up to **Calico Ghost Town**. There we will spend some time learning about the history of the town while we take a train ride through the hills where they mined for silver. There are also some fun shops and buildings to explore.

Tour includes: Round trip deluxe motor coach transportation with water on board; docent tour of the Harvey House Museum; lunch at Peggy Sues and a train ride in Calico.
