It's hard to imagine the 3rd Street Promenade and Santa Monica Place as anything but a bustling sunny outdoor shopping and eating paradise. Here you can meander between the restaurants and store-fronts, with time on your own for lunch.

We continue to the Self-Realization Fellowship Shrine, an internationally-renowned meditation garden offering people from around the world a unique and inspirational oasis. Enjoy time at leisure to stroll the gardens which feature an amazing diversity of colorful plants and trees, meditation nooks, koi ponds, swans, and spectacular ocean vistas. The Court of Religions honors the five principal religions of the world, and the Mahatma Gandhi World Peace Memorial is where a portion of Gandhi's ashes are enshrined.



Lastly, we will cruise Pacific Coast Highway to Pepperdine University and the Stauffer Chapel. This beautiful building is on a stunning vista overlooking the Pacific Ocean and has breath taking views where the stained glass in the

interior of the chapel, radiates with the elegance from the Malibu sun.
