### GUIDED TOUR AT THE GIBBON CONSERVATION CENTER

Spend the morning at the Gibbon Conservation Center. This facility is the only one in the world devoted exclusively to the study, preservation and propagation of gibbons. These small apes are native to the rain forests of Southeast Asia and are considered to be among the world's greatest acrobats. They can leap distances of 50 feet at speeds of up to 35mph while 200 feet above the ground. On your guided tour, you'll get to know these friendly apes as they fascinate and entertain you with their antics!
